


Fund Type	Open-End	<p>The objective of the NIT Islamic Income Fund is to generate a stable Shariah compliant income stream, while seeking maximum possible preservation of capital, over the medium to long-term period, by investing in a diversified portfolio of Shariah Compliant fixed income and money market instruments.</p> <p>Profile of Investment Managers</p> <p>National Investment Trust Ltd. (NITL) is the first and the largest Asset Management Company of Pakistan, formed in 1962. With approximately Rs. 86 billion assets under management as on 28 February 2019, the family of Funds of NIT comprises of ten funds including 4 equity funds, 2 fixed income funds, 1 money market fund, 1 Islamic income fund, 1 conventional pension fund and 1 Islamic pension fund. Auditors	EY Ford Rhodes	<p>The Fund posted an annualized return of 7.65% p.a for the month of February against its benchmark return of 4.09% p.a. The YTD return for FY19 stood at 6.79% p.a. against the benchmark return of 3.10% p.a.</p> <p>The Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the month of February increased to 8.21% versus 7.19% over the previous month. The SMFY19 average CPI inflation now stands at 6.46% compared to 3.84% during the previous fiscal year.</p> <p>As at February 28, 2019, the Fund had an exposure of about 47% of total assets in cash at bank, about 26% in corporate sukuk, 9% in Commercial Paper, 8% in TDRs and the remaining was in the form of other assets. The weighted average time to maturity of the portfolio stood at 356 days.</p>
